# Below are a list of suggested projects that require further study, changes in current policies and/or large investment.

These projects will require concerted advocacy or a more thorough investigation to better formalize them as feasible projects. See below for further explanation on each suggested project.



#### **Long Term Projects:**

- **Public Art Projects** This type was not scene as a top priority in context to other acute needs, but if specific grant or donated funding became available, it could happen in a more expedited timeline.
- **Consolidate Utilities** This type of project requires significant planning and capital investment.
- **Highway Sound Wall** The impact of this project is very important to the neighborhood, however it will require a very dedicated advocacy effort with ODOT to expedite and there is uncertainty if it could be implemented in under 5 years.
- **Street Lights** It is understood that an LED light fixture conversion program through the City of Columbus is already taking place, however there was not specific timeline as to when streetlights would be updated in Franklinton.
- **Intersection Visibility** The intersections identified through this engagement have existing buildings at each corner, therefore making it difficult to address visibility concerns until the private property is redeveloped.
- New Parks, Pocket Parks & Community Spaces The Recreation & Parks Department is exploring a new park at W Broad and W Park Street and in the process of acquiring the appropriate land. Additionally, a new park will be created along Hartford Ave. between Town and State Streets. Timing is TBD.
- Recreational Park- New soccer pitches being added to Sullivant Gardens
   Community Center, however advocacy should continue with Recreation and Parks
   for new facilities in their long-term planning.
- **SR-315 Cap** This project will require significant planning and capital investment and therefore will take quite some time for realization if pursued.
- Splash Pads Will require incorporation into long-term park improvements.
- **Trash Receptacles** Although seemingly feasible, the city has limited capacity to add new trash receptacles and requests further study on strategic locations.
- Additional Flowers & Landscaping- This project will require annual funding and dedicated maintenance from a non-city source.
- **Stop Light/Traffic Lights** Further study required through traffic analysis to warrant the implementation of new stoplights.

## **Likely not Feasible Projects:**

- Add Address to rear of properties current city code does not require addresses in the rear of lots.
- **Evergreen Planting** the city does not currently plant evergreen trees within the city-right-of-way.
- **Stone Curbs** current streetscape standards do not require stone curbs unless in downtown or through historic requirements.
- Traffic Cameras deemed to be illegal in Ohio.
- **Private Landscape Maintenance** the city is unable to maintenance overgrown landscape on private properties and recommends the use of 311 for complaints.
- Public Water Fountains- this is not an initiative the city will support.
- Revive the Florentine Restaurant currently in private possession.
- VEO Bike Docks these bikes do not require specific docking locations.
- Multi-Use Paths in Alleys the city will currently not support this type of use in an alley.
- **Maintain Vacant Lots** The city does not maintain vacant lots and suggests the use of 311 to report issues.
- Street Arches as Gateways not likely an initiative the city will support due to right-of-way concerns.
